**Listen to the Weather Forecast**

- Sunny Day – hat and sunscreen

**Wear Boots or Sturdy Shoes**

to keep your feet warm, dry and free from pokes. Do not wear sandals.



**Wear Long Sleeves and Long Pants**

**Bring Water!**
